A WORD FROM YOUR CHILDREN

In order to gain a child's appreciation of Lugarno, the Lugarno & District Progress Association requested the School headmaster to organise a "This is Lugarno" essay competition, which was incorporated in their school programme. The headmaster and staff organised this competition in two groups — Senior (5th and 6th classes) and Junior (3rd and 4th classes).

The results were most enlightening exhibiting a knowledge of the history of our district and a keen appreciation of the district's advantages and shortcomings. A few extracts and comments are worthy of attention:—

"The history of Lugarno is very interesting. At least 300 years ago (??) two famous explorers, Bass and Flinders, sailed up the Georges River in a rowing boat. Not knowing where they were they gazed with admiration at the beautiful wildflowers that bloomed colourfully in their beds."

"Lugarno is a small but growing residential community with a bushland background."

"— a thriving shopping centre provides reasonable shopping facilities for the modern housewife."

"Lugarno has a lot of beautiful scenery."

Transport: "Buses run regularly every fifteen minutes or half an hour."

"Running from one side of the river to the other is a decrepit ferry."

Industries: "Market Gardening — which is carried on in the crater of an extinct volcano not far from Lugarno Public School."

"— a pottery works on the shores of the Georges River."

"— two stone quarries were once used for cutting stone which was transported by barge to Sydney."

"The first white man used to make a living cutting down trees."

"One important industry is oyster farming."

Improvements: The children invariably commented on lack of playing fields — as one stated:—

"Saturday afternoon when my friends and I desire to play cricket, we're stumped because of the simple fact there is absolutely no playing field within Lugarno. This I feel is shocking."

"Swimming pools are needed in the hot weather."

"Libraries are needed in the everyday life of people."

"Sewerage, not yet in Lugarno, is one marring point that should be attended to."

"I think Lugarno should have some public conveniences so that people travelling on long journeys may stop if necessary."

Among the Juniors, a picture show was specified in most cases, although one stated as follows:—

"We need a sports oval, bridge, tarred roads, shops, bank, theatre and many other things."

In summing up: "I like Lugarno in most ways and will be happy to live here for many years."

"Still I would not give up the simple peaceful dormant life for all the tea in China."
